



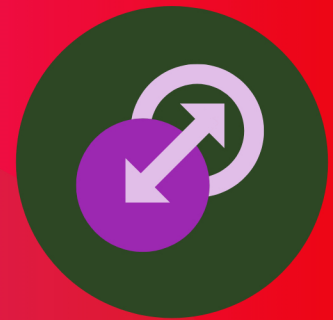
Engaged Students
